### **9/2: Home Sweet Home**

Come explore animal and plant habitats around Silk Farm Sanctuary. Today we learn about the four necessities of life and discuss ways we can help protect these valuable resources.

### **9/17: Bye, Bye, Birdy**

Seasonal changes cause some birds to head south for the winter. Who migrates and why? What obstacles do they face along the way? These questions will be answered and more.

### **10/7: Our Five Senses**
